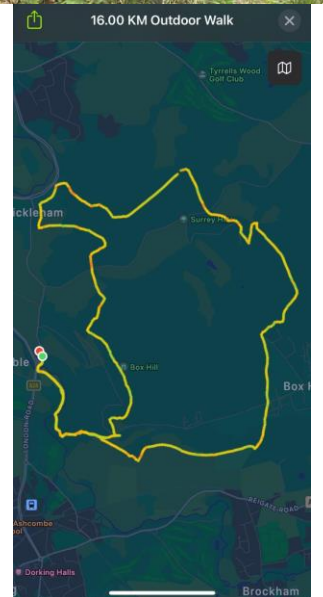
Junior Maths Challenge Winners

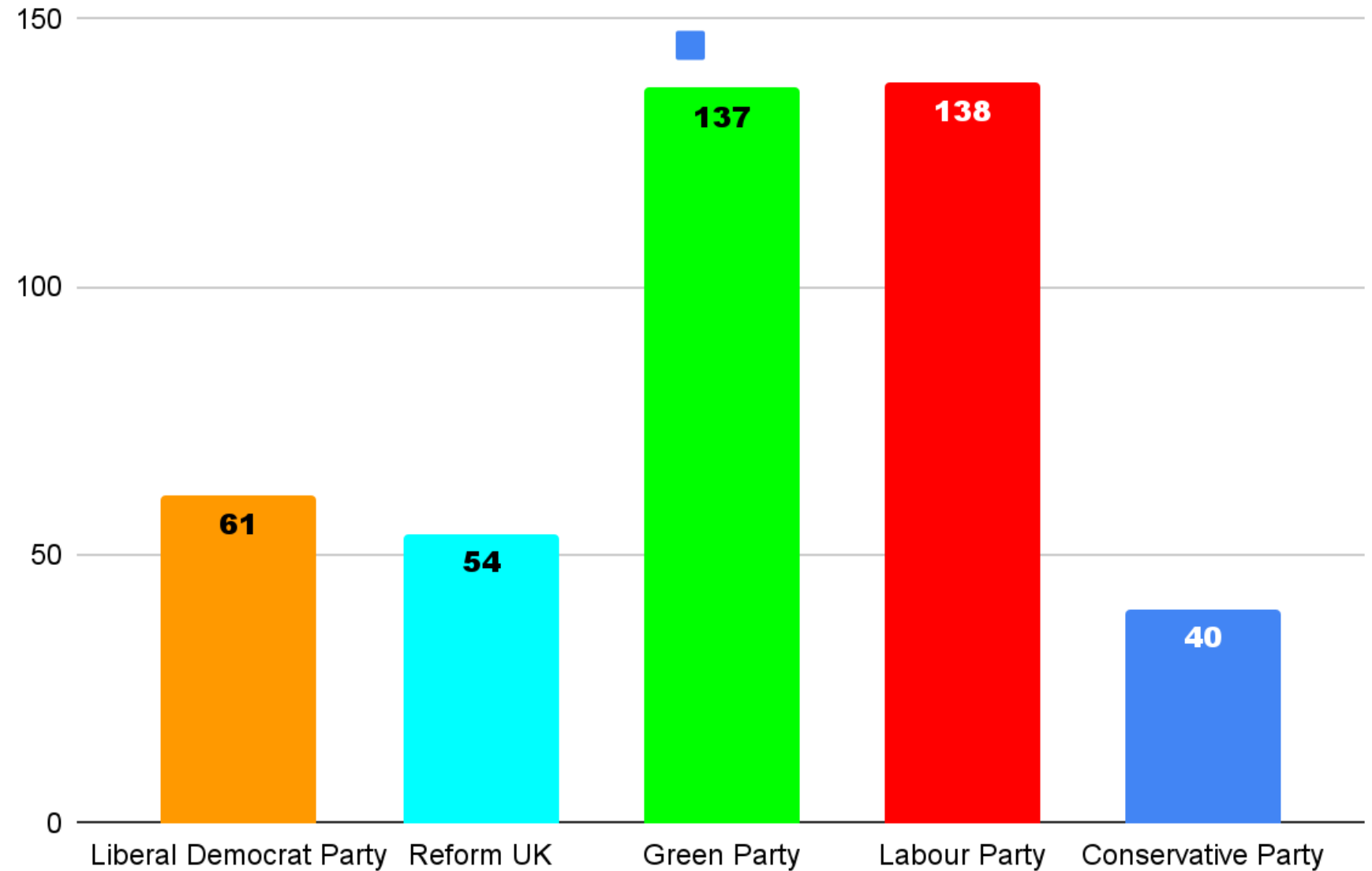
St Michael's Results of Election for Mayor of London 2024

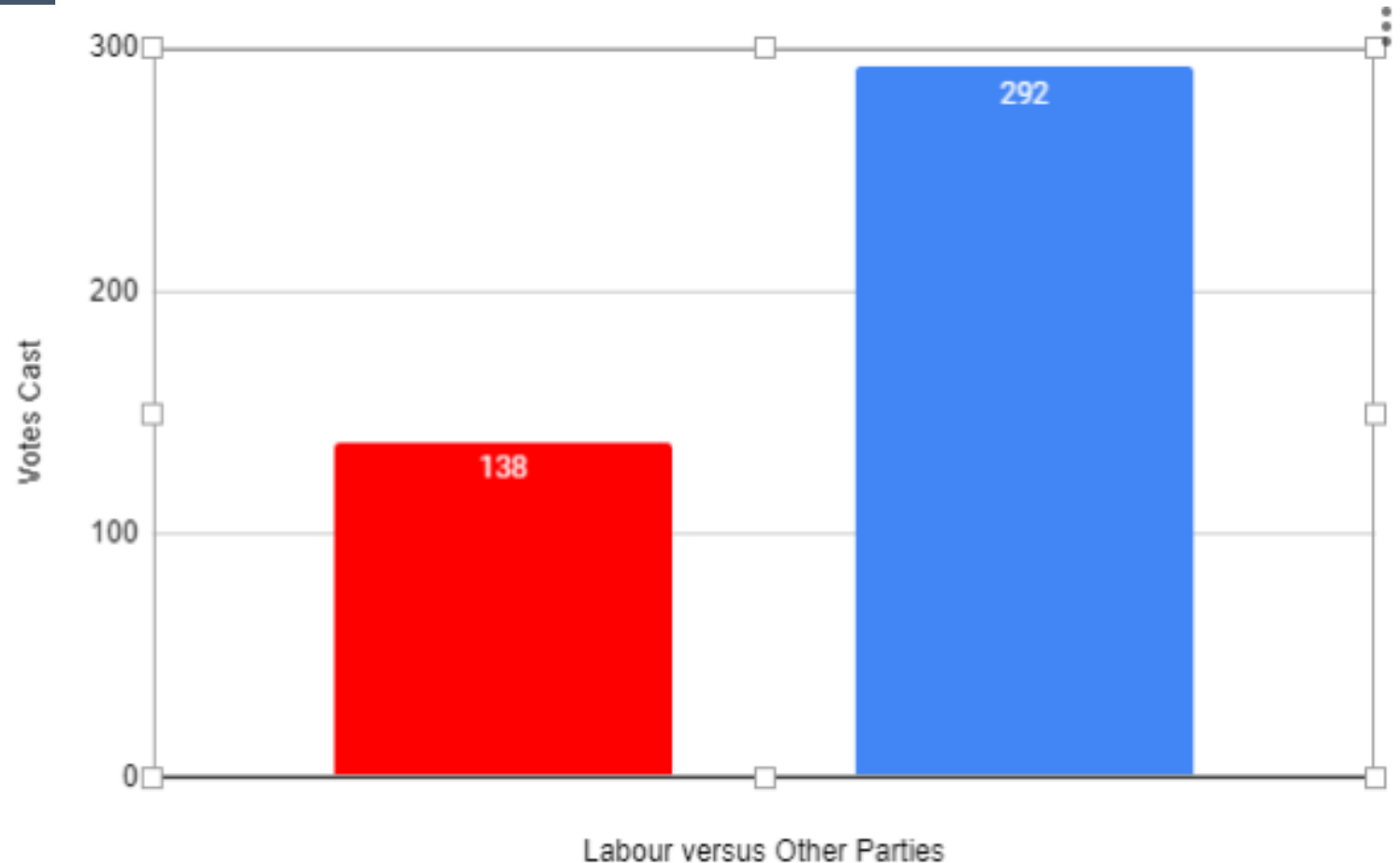
Votes won by Political Party



Why did the Labour Party win?

For London Mayoral (and UK Parliament) elections, we use **the First Past the Post** electoral system.

This means who comes first in the numbers of votes wins, even if more people vote for other parties.

Sadiq Khan, the *incumbent* (already in place) Mayor won re-election for the third time.

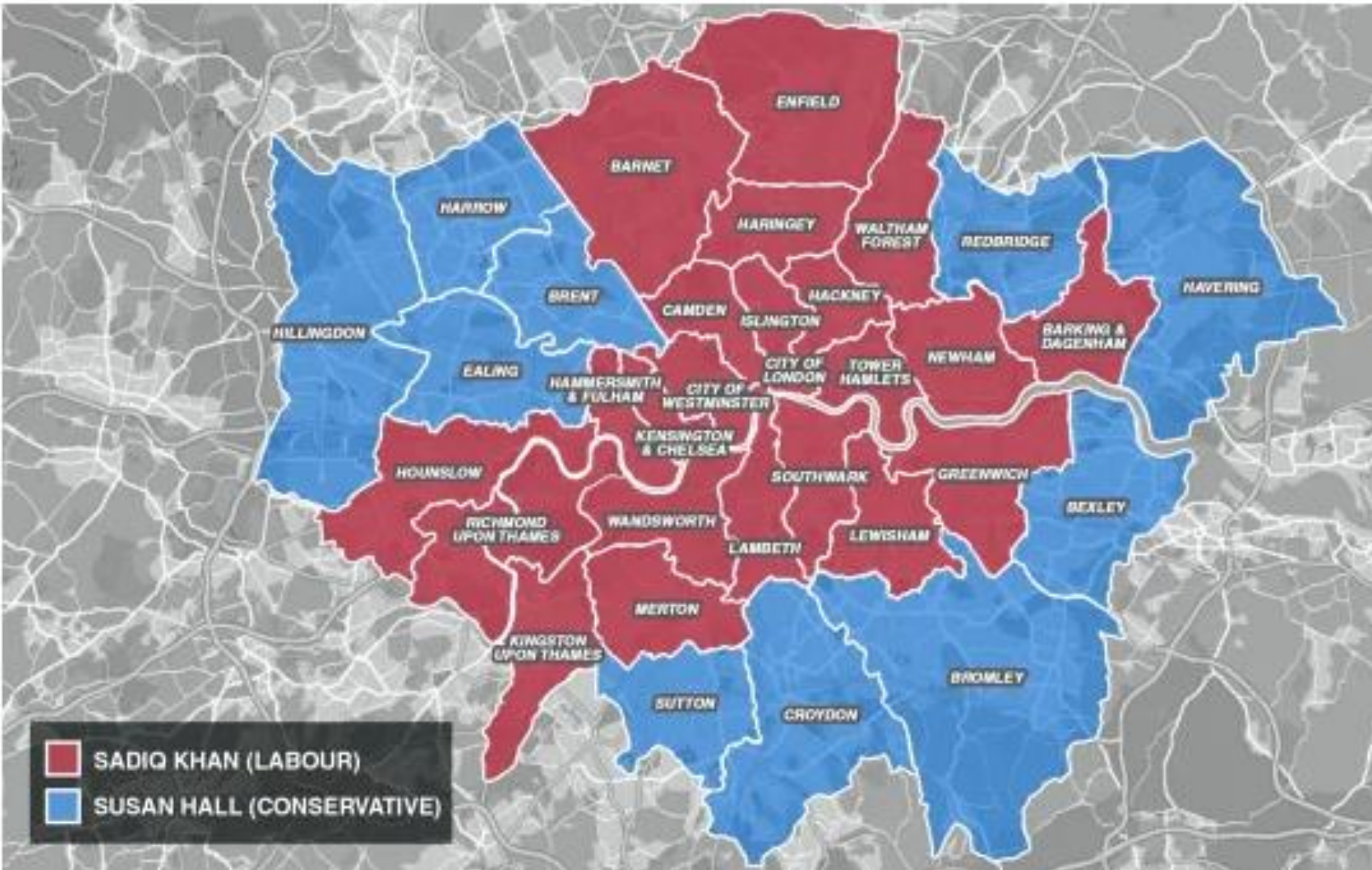
The Conservatives, who came last in the SMCC election, came second.

The Greens came second in St Michael's but fourth in the real election.

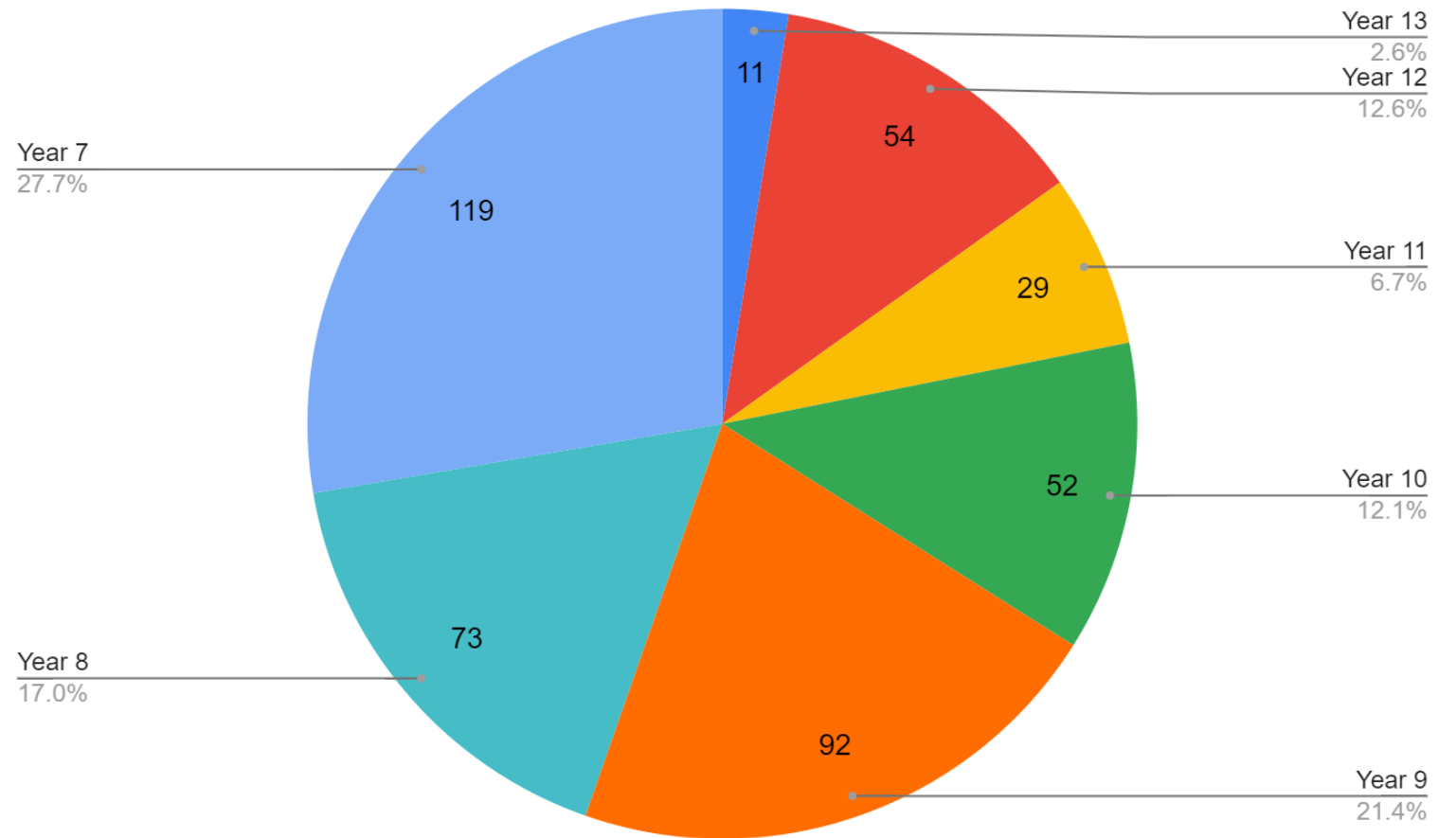
Sadiq Khan won our borough of Southwark and neighbouring boroughs like Lewisham and Lambeth.

Turnout (the percentage of those who could vote who did) was **roughly 46% in St Michael's.**

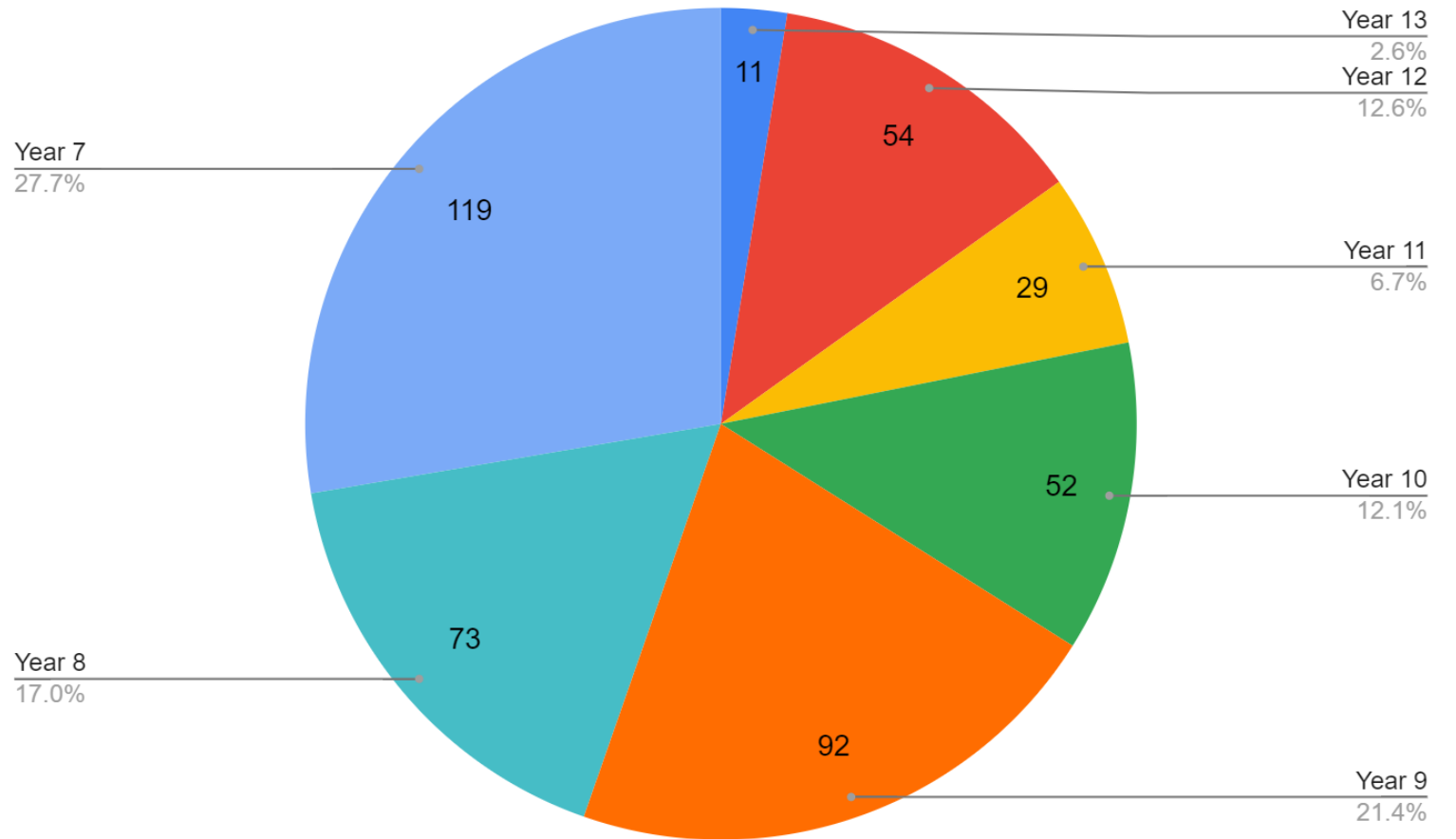
This was higher than in the actual election: **40.5%.**



Turnout by Year Group

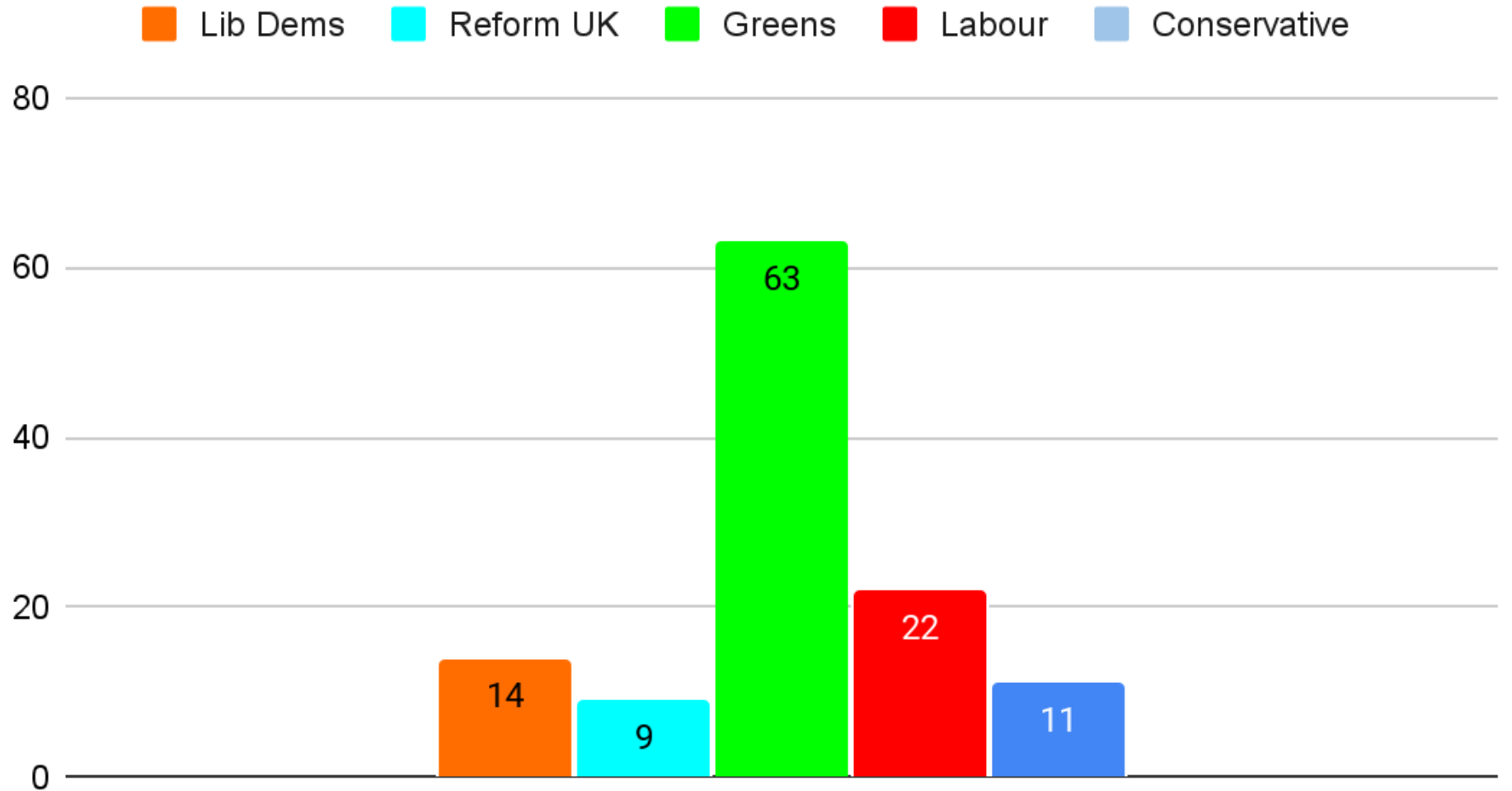
Year 7 had the highest turnout, with 119 votes cast. Well done Year 7!

The worst turnout was from Year 13, with just 11 votes. We hope this is because many were voting in the real election.

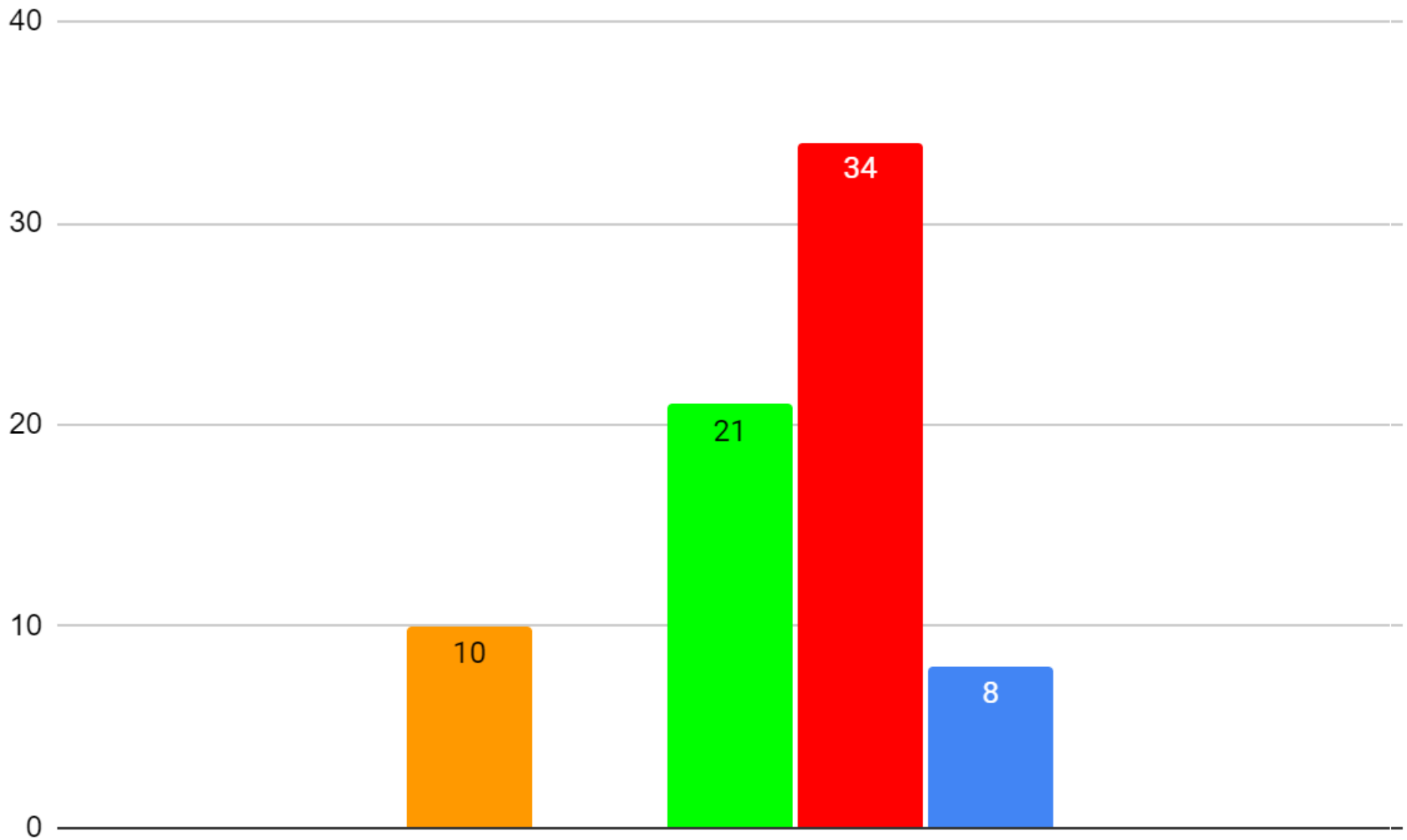

Lib Dems Reform UK Greens Labour Conservative

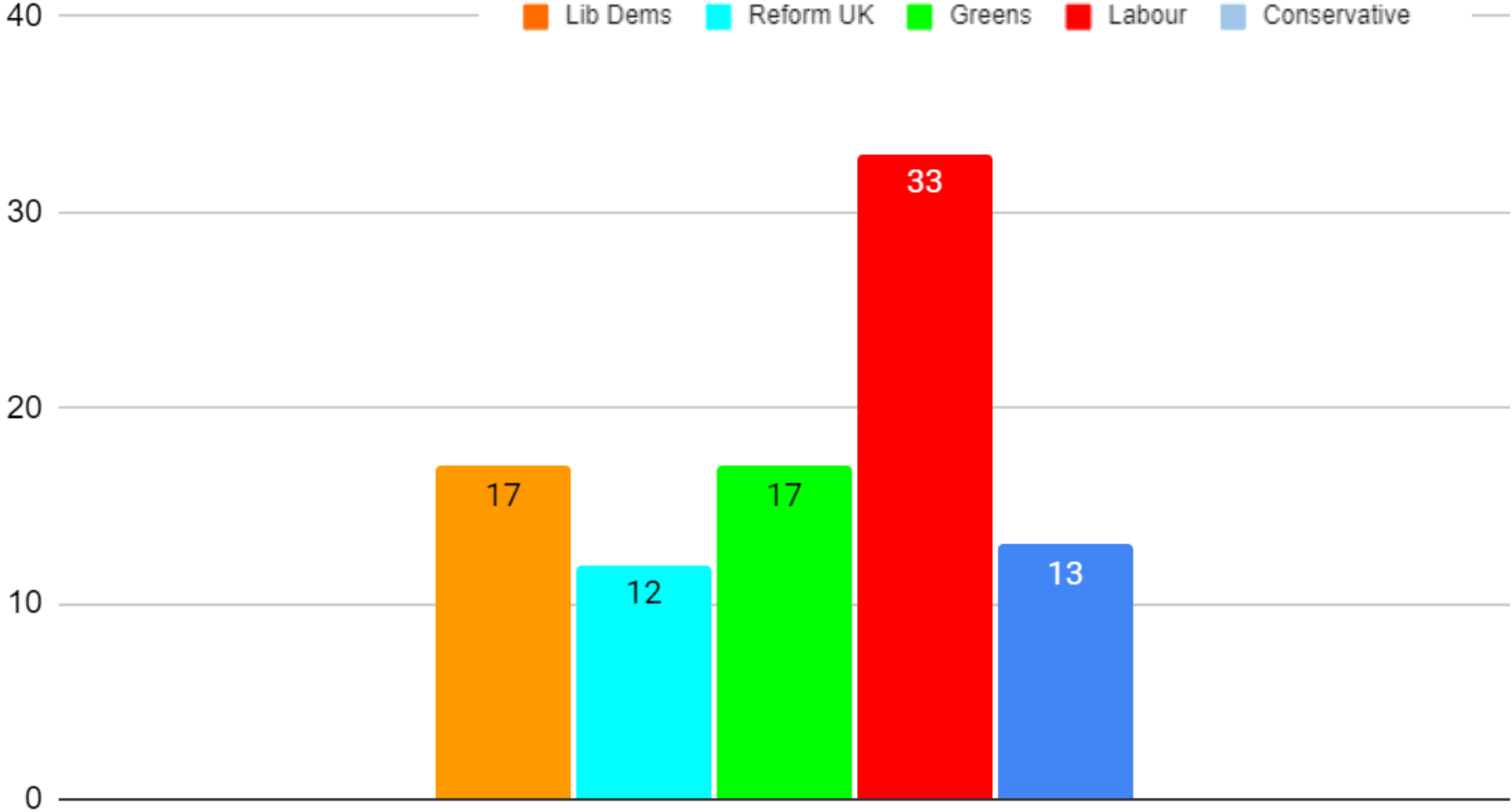


The Labour Party won amongst Year 8s.

Votes cast by Year 9

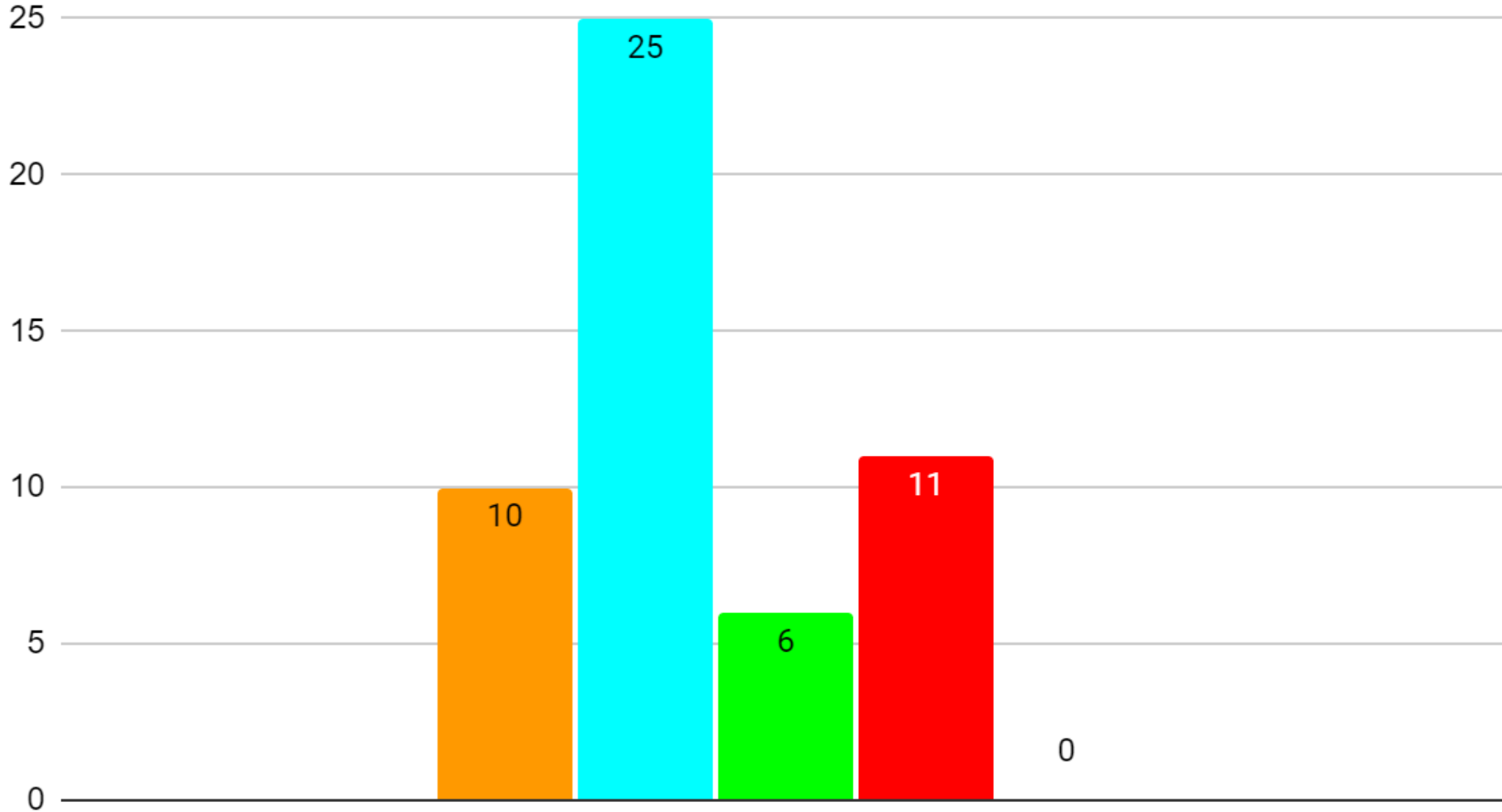


Year 9 had the second highest turnout.

Lib Dems Reform UK Greens Labour Conservative

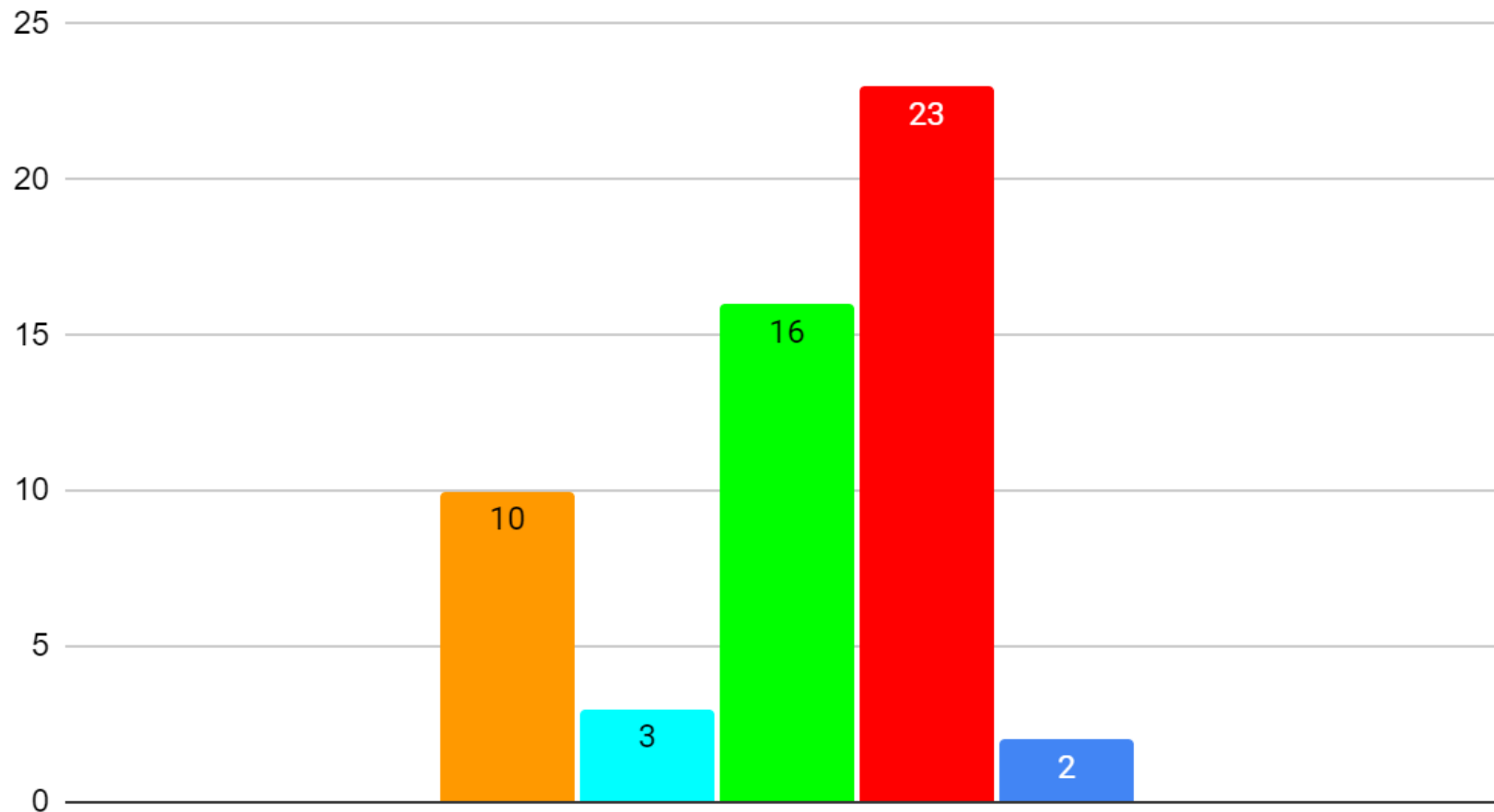


Reform UK won Year 10 by a landslide

By contrast, the (Conservatives) Tories received no votes.

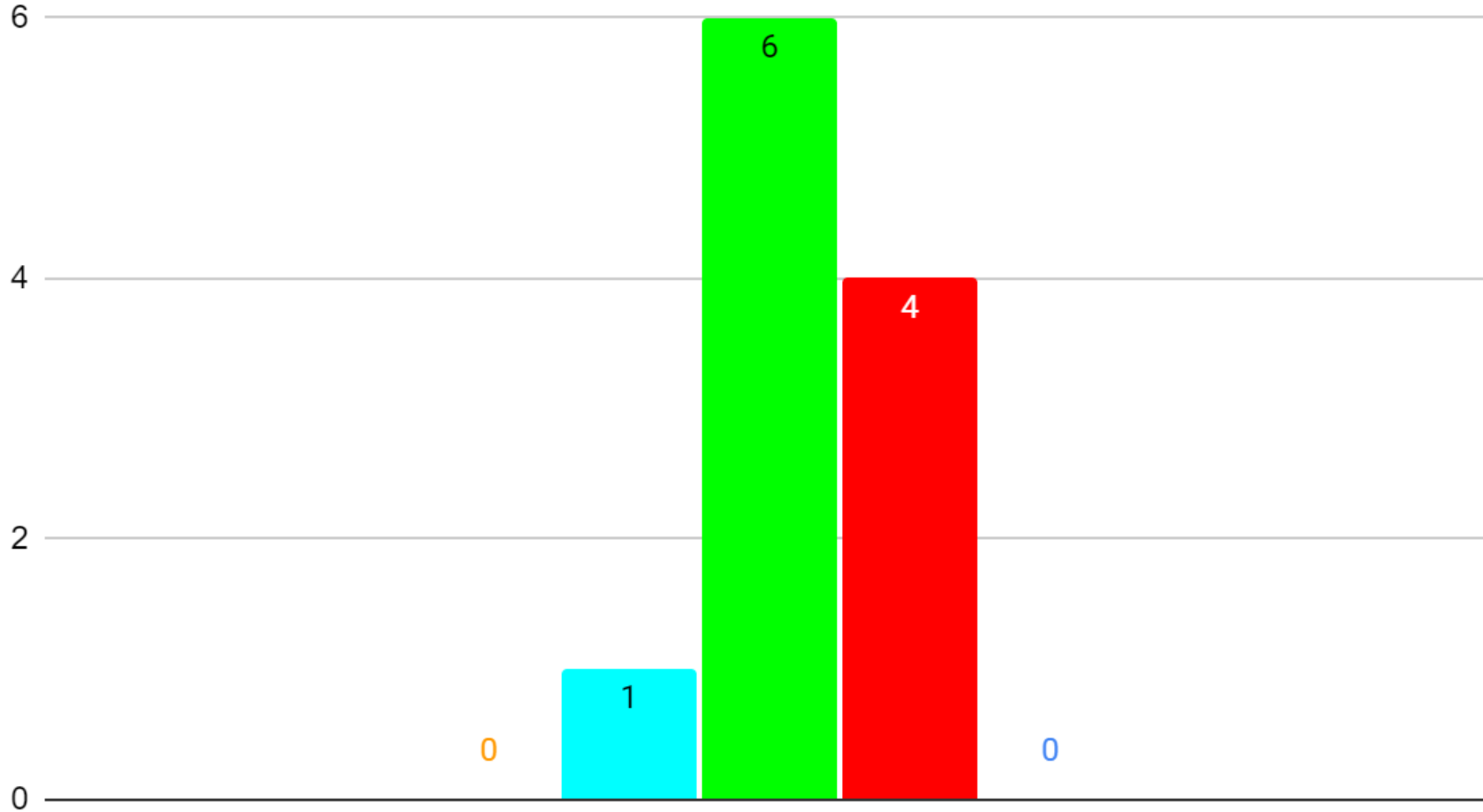
Labour won amongst Year 12s. There is very likely to be a General Election later this year.

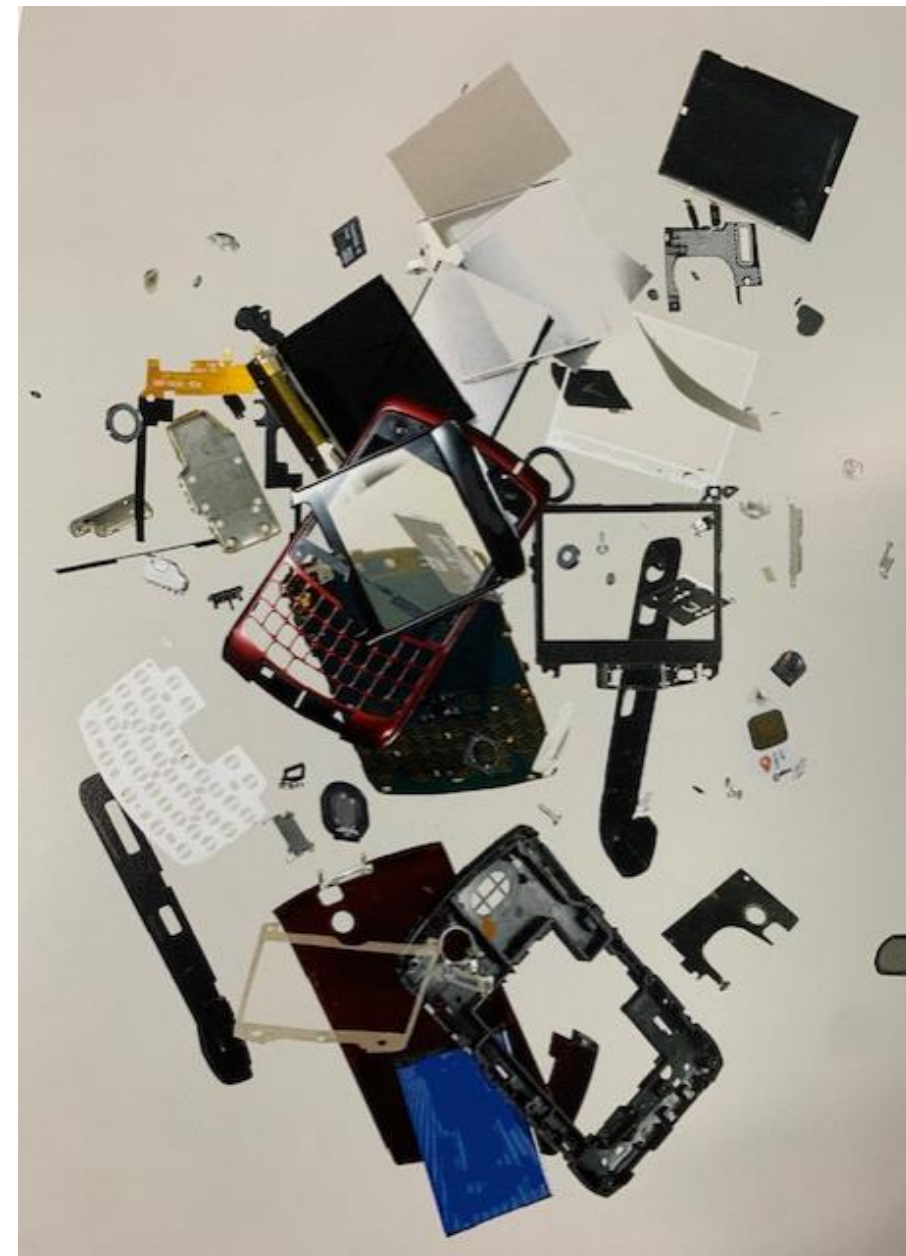

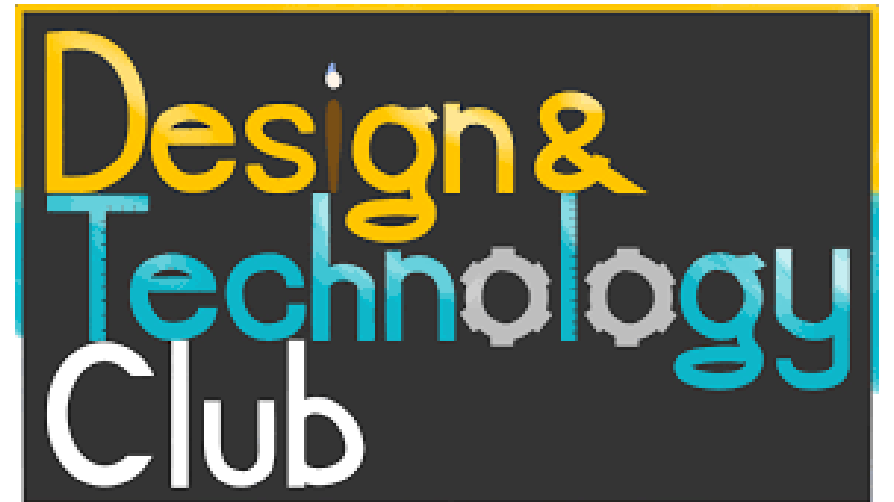
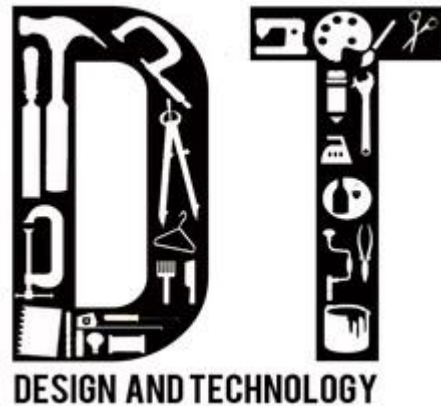
