Saint Helena is a **British overseas territory** located in the **South Atlantic Ocean**. It is a remote volcanic tropical island of the coast of south-western Africa. Saint Helena measures about 16 by 8 km and has a population of 4,439. It was named after **Helena**, mother of **Constantine I**. It was uninhabited when discovered by the **Portuguese** enroute to the **Indian subcontinent** in 1502.

Saint Helena is known for being the site of **Napoleon's** second exile, following his **final defeat** in 1815.

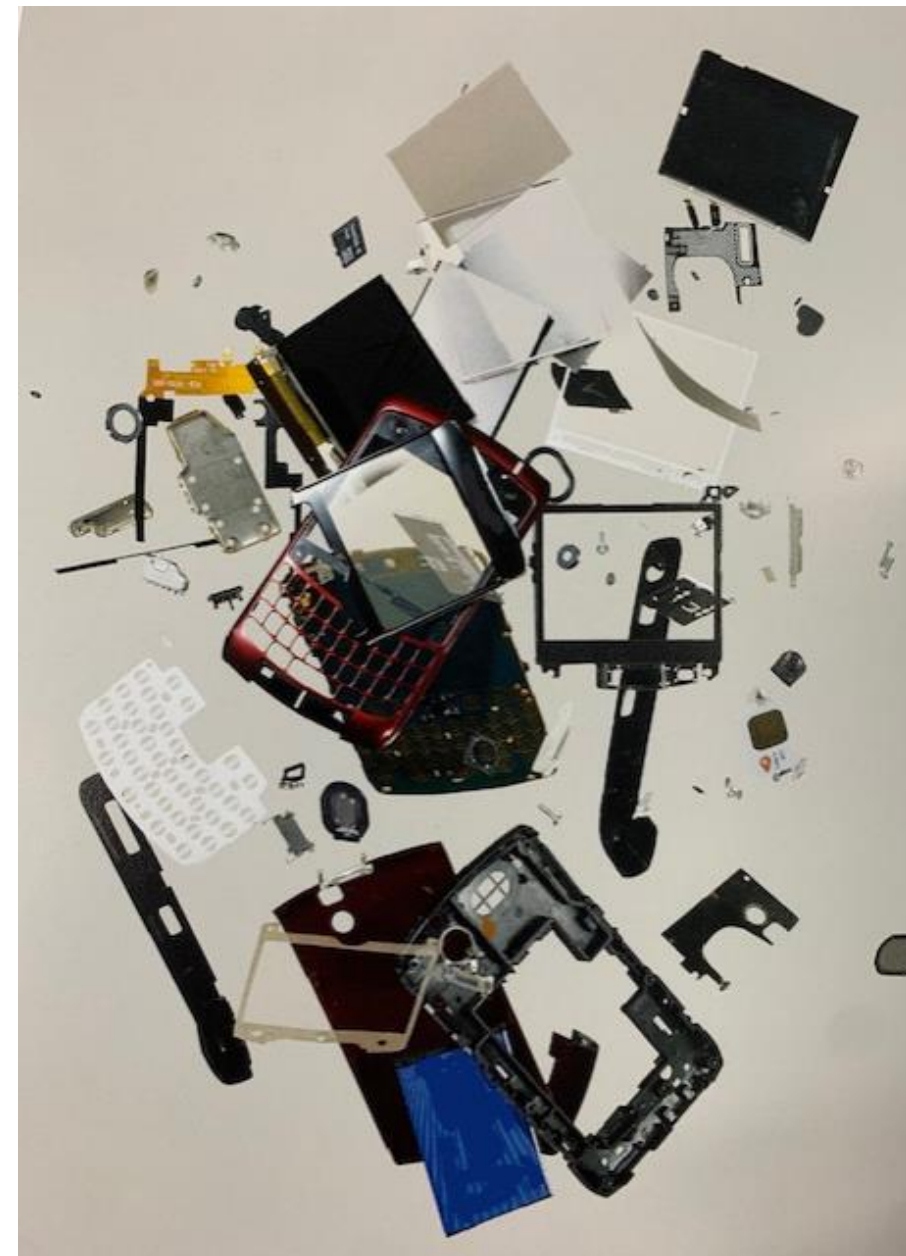

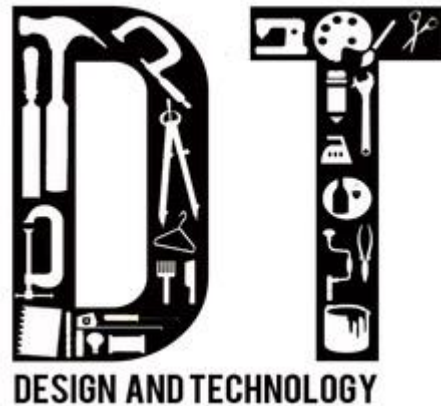
